INTRO:

Ⅰ. → Matthew 1:20-23

But after he had considered this, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream and said, "Joseph son of David, do not be afraid to take Mary home as your wife, because what is conceived in her is from the Holy Spirit."

 → "She will give birth to a son, and you are to give him the name Jesus, because he will save his people from their sins."
All this took place to fulfill what the Lord had said through the prophet: "The virgin will conceive and give birth to a son, and they will call him Immanuel" (which means "God with us").

II. Isaiah 7:14

Therefore the Lord himself will give you a sign: The **virgin** will conceive and give birth to a son, and will call him **Immanuel**.

- A. Heb (*almah*) girl of childbearing age
- B. Grk (parthenos) virgin
- III. Lord tells Noah, "Take your wife and sons with you" (Ge 6:18) He tells Isaac, "Do not be afraid, I am with you" (Ge 26:23) He tells Moses, "I will be with you in Egypt" (Ex 3:12) He tells Joshua, "As I was with Moses, so will I be with you" (1:5) Barak tells Deborah "If you go with me I will go" (Jdg 4:8) Naomi asks Ruth "Why would you come with me" (Ruth 1:11) Saul tells David "Go, and the Lord be with you" (1 Sam 17:37) Psalm 23 says, "I will fear no evil, for you are with me" (Ps 23:4) Psalms 46 says, "Yahweh of Hosts is with us; the God of Jacob is our fortress." (Ps 46:7)

BODY:

I. The Reunion of Family

- A. <u>Christianity is more than just religion, it is community.</u>
 - 1) Acts 2:46-47

Every day they continued to meet together in the temple courts. They broke bread in their homes and ate together with glad and sincere hearts, praising God and enjoying the favor of all the people.

2) MORE IMPORTANT THAN PRESENTS IS YOUR PRESENCE

B. Every get-together is an opportunity to encourage.

1) Hebrews 10:24-25

And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds, not giving up **meeting together**, as some are in the habit of doing, but **encouraging** one another.

1) **Psalms 133:1**

Behold, how good and pleasant it is when brothers dwell **together in unity**!

- 2) Heb (*yachad*) in unity, as one
- 3) FOCUSING ON THE THING WE HAVE IN COMMON
- B. <u>It is in the spirit of unity that Jesus does his greatest work.</u>
 - 1) Matthew 18:19-20

"Again, truly I tell you that if two of you on earth agree about anything they ask for, it will be done for them by my Father in heaven. For where two or three gather in my name, there am I with them."

III. The Bond of Fellowship

- A. <u>After all the years these are things we will remember.</u>
 - 1) Ephesians 4:31-32
