I. Significance in Obscurity

2 But you, Bethlehem, Ephrathah, though you are small among the clans of Judah,

out of you will come for me one who will be ruler over Israel

A. God does not chose people based on their greatness.

1) THEME OF SELECTING INSIGNIFICANT PEOPLE

2) **Exodus 3:11**

Moses—"Who am I that I should go to Pharaoh and bring the Israelites out of Egypt?"

3) **Judges 6:15**

Gideon—"How can I save Israel? My clan is the weakest in Manasseh, and I am the least in my family."

4) 1 Samuel 9:21

Saul—"But am I not a Benjamite, from the smallest tribe of Israel, and is not my clan the least of all the clans of the tribe of Benjamin?"

2) **1 Samuel 16:7**

"The Lord does not look at the things people look at. People look at the outward appearance, but the Lord looks at the heart."

B. Wherever He places us, God can do great things.

1) **1 Corinthians 1:28-29**

God chose the **lowly** things of this world and the despised things—and the things that are not—to nullify the things that are, so that no one may boast before him.

II. Salvation in Lowliness

2 whose family origin is from of **old**, from **ancient times**.

- A. The entire nativity story is a prophecy about lowliness.
 - 1) Luke 2:11-12

"Today in the town of **David** a Savior has been born to you; he is the Messiah, the Lord. This will be a sign to you: You will find a baby **wrapped in strips of cloth** and lying in a **manger**."

- 2) Born in Bethlehem—not in the capital
 No room in the inn—not accepted by his people
 Announced to shepherds—not to the noble court
 Abiding in the fields—not in the royal palace
 Strips of cloth —not in a baby's robe
 Grk (esparganoménon) wrapped in strips
 Lying in a Manger—not in a royal crib
- DAVID MAYO BEEING A SHEEP
- B. Only in humility will we truly discover a Christian life.
 - 1) Philippians 2:5-7

Let the same mind be in you that was in Christ Jesus, who, though he was in the form of God, did not consider equality with God something to be grasped, but emptied himself, taking the form of a servant, being born in human likeness.

III. Strength in Weakness
