  - 1) **John 16:24** Until now you have not asked for anything in my name. Ask and you will receive, and your joy will be complete.
  - 2) **James 4:2** *You have not, because you ask not.*
  - 3) SITTING DOWN WITH THE SCHOOL

# B. <u>The outcome is God's job, the praying is our job.</u>

- John 15:7
   If you remain in me and my words remain in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you.
- 2) "What ever you wish (subj), ask (imp)"
- 3) Knowing how to draw, but do not know what they like We know how to pray, but do we know what we want?
