INTRO:

I. → Galatians 2:6-10

6 As for those who were held in high esteem—whatever they were makes no difference to me; God does not show favoritism—they added nothing to my message. 7 On the contrary, they recognized that I had been entrusted with the task of preaching the gospel to the uncircumcised, just as Peter had been to the circumcised.

- → 8 For God, who was at work in Peter as an apostle to the circumcised, was also at work in me as an apostle to the Gentiles. 9 James, Cephas and John, those esteemed as pillars, gave me and Barnabas the **right hand of fellowship** when they recognized the grace given to me.
- → They agreed that we should go to the Gentiles, and they to the circumcised. 10 All they asked was that we should continue to remember the poor, the very thing I had been eager to do all along.

- III. Marco Antonio de Dominis, Archbishop of Spalato (1624)
 - A. In necessariis unitas, in dubiis libertas, in omnibus caritas.
 - B. "Let us all embrace one another, unity in necessary things, liberty in doubtful things, charity in all things."

I. In Essentials Unity

7 They recognized that I had been entrusted with the task of **preaching the gospel** to the uncircumcised, just as Peter had been to the circumcised.

 - 1) Philippians 1:18

- A. We need to leave room for disputable matters.
 - 1) Romans 14:1

III. In All Things Charity
