INTRO:

I. → Exodus 3:7-8

The Lord said, "I have indeed seen the misery of my people in Egypt. I have heard them crying out because of their slave drivers, and I am concerned about their suffering."

- → "So I have come down to **rescue them from the hand** of the Egyptians and to bring them up out of that land into a good and spacious land, a land flowing with milk and honey."

BODY:

I. A Hand That Holds Out

- A. Sometimes what we need is a hand stronger than ours.
 - 1) **1 Samuel 17:37**

"The Lord who **rescued** me from the paw of the lion and the paw of the bear will **rescue** me from the hand of this Philistine."

- B. The salvation of Jesus is more than just spiritual.
 - 1) Luke 1:68-75

He has raised up a horn of salvation for us in the house of his servant David...

to rescue us from the hand of our enemies, and to enable us to serve him without fear in holiness and righteousness before him all our days.

- B. <u>It is not always big miracles that save a person's life.</u>
