4-I Will Build My Church

INTRO:

I. → Matthew 16:13-20

13 When Jesus came to the region of Caesarea Philippi, he asked his disciples, "Who do people say the Son of Man is?"
14 They replied, "Some say John the Baptist; others say Elijah; and still others, Jeremiah or one of the prophets."
15 "But what about you?" he asked. "Who do you say I am?"

- → 16 Simon Peter answered, "You are the Messiah, the Son of the living God." 17 Jesus replied, "Blessed are you, Simon son of Jonah, for this was not revealed to you by flesh and blood, but by my Father in heaven. 18 And I tell you that you are Peter, and on this rock I will build my church, and the gates of Hades will not overcome it.
- → 19 I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven; whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you **loose on** earth will be loosed in heaven." 20 Then he ordered his disciples not to tell anyone that he was the Messiah.

BODY:

I. Revealing the King

16 Simon Peter answered, "You are the Messiah, the Son of the living God." 17 Jesus replied, "Blessed are you, Simon son of Jonah, for this was not revealed to you by flesh and blood, but by my Father in heaven.

- A. Everything begins with a revelations of the King.
 - 1) **Daniel 7:27**

And the kingdom and the dominion and the greatness of the kingdoms under the whole heaven shall be given to the people of the saints of the Most High; their kingdom shall be an everlasting kingdom, and all dominions shall serve and obey them. (ESV)

- 2) THE CANOPY WHEN THEY ANOINT THE KING
- B. Jesus anoints us to show that world who He is.
 - His father is John, but He calls him "Son of Jonah"
 What will you do with the revelation
 - 2) **Matthew 11:27**

"All things have been committed to me by my Father. No one knows the Son except the Father, and no one knows the Father except the Son and those to whom the Son chooses to reveal him."

II. Rebuilding the Community

18 And I tell you that **you are Peter**, and on this rock **I will build my church**, and the gates of Hades will not overcome it.

- A. He is not talking about an institution but a community.
 - Peter says, "Ant hu Mashicha b'reh d'Aloha Haya"
 Jesus says, "Ant hu Kipha, v'al hade kipha ebneyh lid'tiy"
 - 2) Aram (*det*); Heb (*edah*) community, congregation 77 times in Ex, Lev, Num, Josh, but rarely in prophets Usage stops in 1 Kings 12:20, when Israel split
 - 3) Exodus 12:3-4

Tell the whole **community** of Israel that on the tenth day of this month each man is to take a lamb for his family, one for each household.

- B. Jesus is rebuilding His community one stone at time.
 - 1) Aram (evneyh); Heb (banah) to build, rebuild
 - 2) Amos 9:11

"In that day
"I will restore David's fallen shelter—
I will repair its broken walls
and restore its ruins—
and will **rebuild** it as it used to be."

3) **Isaiah 61:4**

They will **rebuild** the ancient ruins and restore the places long devastated; they will renew the ruined cities that have been devastated for generations.

4) **Jeremiah 31:3-4**

"I have loved you with an everlasting love; I have drawn you with unfailing kindness. I will **build you up again**, and you, Virgin Israel, will be rebuilt."

III. Releasing the Captives

19 "I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven; whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven."

- A. He has given us keys that unlock every heavenly blessing.
 - Aram (tesuwr) bind, forbid Aram (teshrey) loose, allow
 - 2) **Isaiah 61:1**

The Spirit of the Sovereign Lord is on me, because the Lord has anointed me to proclaim good news to the poor. He has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim freedom for the captives and release from darkness for the prisoners.

- B. It is up to us the throw open every prison door.
 - 1) **Revelation 1:18**

I am the Living One; I was dead, and now look, I am alive for ever and ever! And I hold the keys of death and Hades.
