INTRO:

I. → Acts 7:44-52

*“Our forefathers had the tabernacle of the Testimony **with them** in the desert. It had been made as God directed Moses, according to the pattern he had seen. Having received the **tabernacle**, our fathers under Joshua brought it with them when they took the land from the nations God drove out before them.”*

→ 45 *“It remained in the land until the time of David, who enjoyed God’s favor and asked that he might provide a **dwelling place** for the God of Jacob. But it was Solomon who built the house for him. However, the Most High does not live in houses made by men.*

→ 48 *As the prophet says:*

‘Heaven is my throne,

and the earth is my footstool.

What kind of house will you build for me?’

says the Lord.

*‘Or where will my **resting place** be?*

Has not my hand made all these things?’

(Isaiah 66:1-2)

→ 51 *“You stiff-necked people, with uncircumcised hearts and ears! You are just like your fathers: You always resist the Holy Spirit!”*

II. ALADDIN—ITTY BITTY LIVING SPACE

BODY:

I. Resting in Our Camp

A. It was not God’s original plan to live in a building or a box.

1) 1 Chronicles 17:5-6

*“I have moved from one tent site to another, from one **dwelling place** to another. Wherever I have moved with all the Israelites, did I ever say to any of their leaders whom I*

commanded to shepherd my people, 'Why have you not built me a house of cedar?'"

- 2) THE TEMPLES OF THE ANCIENT NEAR EAST
- 3) BRINGING THE ARK OF GOD INTO THE CAMP

B. The Lord wants his presence to be with us always.

- 1) **Psalms 132:13-15**

*For the Lord has chosen Zion,
he has desired it for his dwelling, saying,
"This is my resting place for ever and ever;
here I will sit enthroned, for I have desired it.
I will bless her with abundant provisions;
her poor I will satisfy with food."*

- 2) BRINGING THE HOLY SPIRIT HOME FROM CAMP

II. Resting in Our Midst

A. People are always trying to put God back in the box.

- 1) **1 Corinthians 3:16**

*Don't you know that you yourselves are God's temple and that God's Spirit dwells in your **midst**?*

- 2) FIRST, SECOND, AND THIRD TEMPLE

- 3) Corinth had temples to Aphrodite atop the Acrocorinth (1,000 temple prostitutes), Poseidon (ruler of the sea), Apollo, Hermes, Venus-Fortuna, Isis, and the Pantheon (All the Gods). But no temple to the God of Israel.

B. It is our fellowship that the Lord blesses with his presence.

- 1) **Ephesians 2:21-22**

*In whom the whole building, being fitted together, grows into a holy temple in the Lord, in whom you also are being built together for a **dwelling place** of God in the Spirit.
(NKJV)*

- 2) DO WE REALLY NEED TO GATHER IN PERSON

III. Resting in Our Hearts

A. Jesus opened the way for His Spirit to rest in our hearts.

1) **Hebrews 10:22-23**

Let us draw near to God with a sincere heart and with the full assurance that faith brings, having our hearts sprinkled to cleanse us from a guilty conscience and having our bodies washed with pure water.

2) **TEARING THE CURTAIN FROM TOP TO BOTTOM**

B. With Jesus in our hearts, our hearts can be at rest in Him.

1) **1 John 3:19-21**

This is how we know that we belong to the truth and how we set our hearts at rest in his presence: If our hearts condemn us, we know that God is greater than our hearts, and he knows everything.
