BODY:

I. Washing Away the Guilt

Heb (rachatsu) wash yourselves; (hizaku) purify yourselves

- A. Before we can move on we must deal with our guilt.
 - 1) **Psalms 24:3-4**

Who may ascend the mountain of the Lord? Who may stand in his holy place? The one who has clean hands and a pure heart.

- 2) THE RED DYE OF THE KERMES VERMILIO Exodus 28:5 (*tola'at shaniy*) the crimson bug
- 3) LADY MACBETH
 "Yet here's a spot. Out, cursed spot, out, I say!"
- B. The blood of Jesus purifies us and prepares us to serve.
 - 1) **Hebrews 10:22**

Let us draw near to God with a sincere heart and with the full assurance that faith brings, having our hearts sprinkled to cleanse us from a guilty conscience and having our bodies washed with pure water.

2) THE CYCLE OF GUILT, ADDICTION, AND SHAME

II. Turning Away from Evil

Heb (cuwr) turn away the evil from your doing

- A. Each day is an opportunity to examine our hearts afresh.
 - 1) **Psalms 139:23-24**

Search me, O God, and know my heart; test me and know my thoughts. See if there is any wicked way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting. (NRSV)

2) ANGEL AND DEVIL ON OUR SHOULDERS

- B. We can either be drawn to darkness or turn away from it.
 - 1) **Ephesians 4:22-23**

You were taught, with regard to your former way of life, to put off your old self, which is being corrupted by its deceitful desires; to be made new in the attitude of your minds.

2) LEGALIZATION OF DRUGS

III. Doing the Right Thing

16 Stop doing wrong. Learn to do right.

- A. God cares more about our actions than our rituals.
 - 1) JUSTICE WOVEN INTO THE FABRIC OF THE UNIVERSE
 - 2) **Psalms 72:1-2**

Endow the king with your justice, O God, the royal son with your righteousness. May he judge your people in righteousness, your afflicted ones with justice.

- 3) CORONATION OF KING CHARLES III
 - 1) ANOINTING—"On the crown of the head, saying: Be your head anointed with holy oil, as kings, priests, and prophets were anointed."
 - 2) SWORD—"With this sword do justice, stop the growth of iniquity, protect the holy Church of God and all people of goodwill, help and defend widows and orphans, restore the things that are gone to decay, maintain the things that are restored, punish and reform what is amiss, and confirm what is in good order."
 - 3) ROBE—"Receive this robe: may the Lord clothe you with the robe of righteousness, and with the garments of salvation."

- B. At the end of the day it is about God reaching lost people.
 - 1) **James 1:27**

Religion that God our Father accepts as pure and faultless is this: to look after orphans and widows in their distress and to keep oneself from being polluted by the world.
