## ||. → Psalms 89:5-16

1 I will sing of the Lord's great love forever; with my mouth I will make your faithfulness known through all generations.

2 I will declare that your love stands firm forever, that you have established your faithfulness in heaven itself.

- → 3 You said, "I have made a covenant with my chosen one, I have sworn to David my servant, 4 'I will establish your line forever and make your throne firm through all generations."
- A. In the South it is always about David
- B. Changes from 4 meters to 3
- → 5 The heavens praise your wonders, YHWH, your faithfulness too, in the assembly of the holy ones. 6 For who in the skies above can compare with YHWH? Who is like the YHWH among the heavenly beings?
- → 7 In the council of the holy ones God is greatly feared; he is more **awesome** than all who surround him.

# 8 Who is like you, O YHWH God of Hosts? O Mighty Yah! with your faithful ones around you.

→ 15 Blessed are those who have learned to acclaim you, who walk in the light of your presence, Lord.

16 They rejoice in your name all day long; they celebrate your righteousness.

## III. A BLESSING FOR YOM TERUAH (ROSH HOSHANA)

- A. O How blessed are the people who know TERUAH!
  - 1) Know the joyful sound (KJV)
  - 2) Know the festal shout (RSV)
  - Acclaim: to welcome or salute with shouts or sounds of joy and approval

(The Paragogic Nun)

In the light of your face they shall walk! (yihalekuN) In you name they shall rejoice (y'giyluN) all day long. In your righteousness they shall be exalted.

- B. Yom Teruah "Day of Trumpeting"
  - a) Blowing the shofar to announce His Kingship!
  - b) Coronation of God as King of the Universe
  - c) Proclaiming to the world that God is on the throne
  - d) Psalms 47:5-7
