INTRO:

I. → Ezekiel 36:24-29

"And I will take you from the nations, and I will gather you from all the lands, and I will bring you into your own land. And I will sprinkle clean water upon you, and you will be cleansed from all your uncleannesses, and from all your idols I will cleanse you." → 26 "And I will give you a new heart, and put a new **spirit** within you; and I will take the heart of stone from your flesh and give you a heart of flesh. And I will put my **Spirit** within you, and cause you to walk in my statutes, so my justices you shall keep and do." → 28 "And you will dwell in the land which I gave to your forefathers; and you will be my people, and I will be your God. 29 And I will save you from all your uncleannesses."

II. Heb (*tumah*) to profane, defile, polluteHeb (*taher*) to cleanse, purge, purify

BODY:

I. A Clean Start

and you will be **cleansed** from all your **uncleannesses**, and from all your **idols** I will cleanse you.

- A. <u>We cannot expect different results from the same choices.</u>
 - 1) Isaiah 52:11

Depart, depart, go out from there! Touch no **unclean** thing! Come out from her and be **pure**, you who carry the articles of the Lord's house. Heb (barar) pure, clear, chosen 2 Corinthians 2:17

- 2) PURIFYING ISRAEL FROM IDOLATRY
- 3) GETTING RID OF THE COMPUTER VIRUS
- B. <u>Sometimes we need to simply leave the old ways behind us.</u>
 - 1) Ephesians 4:22-23

You were taught, with regard to your former way of life, to put off your old self, which is being corrupted by its deceitful desires; to be made **new** in the attitude of your minds.

2) NOT HANGING OUT WITH SAME FRIENDS

<mark>ll. An Pure Heart</mark>

and I will take the **heart** of stone from your flesh and give you a **heart** of flesh.

- A. <u>Whenever God restores us He begins with the heart.</u>
 - 1) **Psalms 24:3-4**

Who may ascend the mountain of the Lord? Who may stand in his holy place? The one who has clean hands and a **pure heart**, who does not trust in an idol or swear by a false god.

- 2) CLEANING OUT THE WOUND
- B. <u>Until our hearts are right, nothing in our lives will be right.</u>
 - 1) 2 Timothy 2:22

Flee the evil desires of youth and pursue righteousness, faith, love and peace, along with those who call on the Lord out of a **pure heart**.

- 2) ZELINSKI BEING KICKED OUT OF THE WHITE HOUSE
- 3) "What God makes clean, do not call unclean" (Acts 10:15)

III. A Spirit Impart

And I will put **my Spirit within you**, (plural) so my **justice** you shall keep and do.

- A. <u>We will never be new until the Holy Spirit takes over.</u>
 - 1) Psalms 51:10-12

Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a **right spirit** within me. Cast me not away from your presence, and take not your **Holy Spirit** from me. Restore to me the joy of your salvation, and uphold me with a **willing spirit**.

- 2) Heb (*ruach nakown*) spirit of uprightness Heb (*ruach qadash*) spirit of holiness Heb (*ruach nadiyba*) spirit of willingness
- 3) THE WOOD SPRITE GIVING PINOCCHIO A CRICKET Wings from Isaiah 6; Eyes from Ezekiel 10
- B. <u>He places His Holy Spirit within us so we can live again.</u>
 - 1) Titus 3:5

He saved us, not because of righteous things we had done, but because of his mercy. He saved us through the washing of rebirth and **renewal** by the **Holy Spirit**.
