1. Titus 3:1-2

Remind the people to be subject to rulers and authorities, to be obedient, to be ready to do whatever is good, to slander no one, to be peaceable and considerate, and always to be **gentle** toward everyone.

2. Points to Remember

- A. Meekness is not weakness, it is strength under control.
- B. More can be accomplished by meekness than by unchecked anger.
- C. Without due consideration we can do more harm than good.
- D. We can still be persuasive without becoming argumentative.
- E. Humility wins more people over than any great achievement.
- F. Humility is more of a lifestyle than a one-time decision.
