1 Peter 4:12-19

12 Dear friends, do not be surprised at the fiery ordeal that has come on you to test you , as though something strange were happening to you.	<i>xenízo</i> <i>púrosis</i> <i>prós peirasmós</i> <i>xénos</i>
13 But rejoice inasmuch as you participate in the sufferings of Christ, so that you may be overjoyed when his glory is revealed.	<i>chaíro</i> <i>koinonéo</i> <i>páthema</i> <i>agalliáo</i> <i>dóxa</i>
14 If you are insulted because of the name of Christ, you are blessed , for the Spirit of glory and of God rests on you.	<i>oneidízo</i> <i>ónoma</i> <i>makários</i> <i>pneúma</i> <i>dóxa</i> <i>anapaúo</i>
15 If you suffer , it should not be as a murderer or thief or any other kind of criminal , or even as a meddler .	<i>páscho</i> <i>phoneús</i> <i>kléptes</i> <i>kakopoíós</i> <i>allotriepískopos</i>
16 However, if you suffer as a Christian , do not be ashamed , but praise God that you bear that name.	<i>páscho</i> <i>Xristianós</i> <i>aischúnomai</i> <i>doxázo</i>

17 For it is time for **judgment**
to **begin** with God's household;
and if it **begins** with us,
what will the **outcome** be
for those who **do not obey**
the gospel of God?
